SASKATCHEWAN EXPRESS - AUDITION INFORMATION

VOCALISTS / DANCERS - PLEASE READ CAREFULLY!!!

- Please note: for the Saskatchewan Express Winter Tour all performers are expected to sing and dance.
 - You will be notified of your audition time and the time you should report to the Registration Desk.
 - Your individual audition will be 10 minutes in length.
 - All auditionees are required to perform two songs in a contrasting style. Length should not exceed 32 bars or one verse and one chorus.
 - You may use back up CD's, use our accompanist or bring your own accompanist.
- * **We encourage you to supply your own accompaniment as this makes the audition process more comfortable. If you have no other option and have indicated you will be using the *Saskatchewan Express* accompanist, sheet music must be received at our office, with your application, by the June 4th deadline.**
- When you arrive for your audition, please hand in vocal back-up CD's to the receptionist who will give them to the sound technician. Please make sure all CD's are marked with your name and the order of the songs.
 - Please prepare a short monologue (one minute). A monologue is speech from a play, or a soliloquy. If you do not have a monologue you will be given an impromptu improvisation scenario during your audition. Monologues can be found at most libraries.
 - All Auditionees will be expected to participate in a short dance routine at their individual audition. Or if you are primarily a dancer, please prepare a two-minute dance number for your individual audition.
 - Also at the audition, all auditionees will be required to learn a part in a SATB (Soprano, Alto, Tenor, Baritone) vocal score. Using this SATB piece you will also be taught on-the-spot choreography and perform the vocal ensemble number with other performers.
 - Please wear comfortable clothing and comfortable low-heeled shoes. No street shoes please.
 - **CALL BACKS** *may* be held following the auditions.
 - All Auditionees will be informed with the results of the audition as soon as possible.

Saskatchewan Express will make every effort to ensure that your audition will be a pleasant and rewarding experience.
